

Student Admission for Undergraduate Programs

The Indonesian Institute of The Arts (ISI) Denpasar carries out new student admissions held with reference to the Regulation of the Minister of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology (Kemendikbudristek) Number 48 of 2022 concerning New Student Admissions for Diploma and Undergraduate Programs at State Universities. The undergraduate and diploma student admission system follows the National Selection for New Student Admissions (SNPMB) of Kemendikbudristek which includes three channels, namely: (1) National Selection Based on Achievement (SNBP), (2) National Selection Based on Tests (SNBT), and (3) admission system through independent channels.

SNBP is one of the selection channels for university admission which is carried out based on the results of tracing academic achievements through report and students' academic and non-academic portfolios. The national selection based on achievement focuses on providing high rewards for comprehensive learning success in secondary education. Selection focuses on the reward of comprehensive learning success in secondary education. This is implemented by giving a minimum weight of 50 percent to the average score on the report for all subjects. Meanwhile, for the remaining weight, a maximum of 50 percent is taken from the interest and talent exploration components. Prospective students are emphasized to have holistic and cross-disciplinary competencies, because to be successful in the future, a variety of competencies are required.

SNBT is a test-based national selection for admission to state universities based on Computer Based Selection Test (UTBK) and can also be supplemented with criteria from state universities or institutions regulations. SNBT selection focuses on measuring reasoning and problem-solving abilities. In this selection, there is no subject test, but a scholastic test measuring four things, namely cognitive potential, mathematical reasoning, literacy in Indonesian and English language. The questions in this selection focus on students' reasoning abilities and not memorization.

Independent channel selection by ISI Denpasar is regulated under the Regulation of Rector Number 8 of 2023 concerning New Student Admission for Independent Selection of Undergraduate and Applied Undergraduate Programs within ISI Denpasar. Before carrying out the independent selection, ISI Denpasar as a Public University/Institution (PTN) announced several things, such as the number of prospective students who would be accepted by each study program, method of assessing prospective students consisting of independent tests, cooperative test through a consortium of higher education institutions, utilizing scores from national selection results based on tests, and/or other required student candidate assessment methods; as well as the amount of admission fees charged for prospective students passing the selection. Arer carrying out the independent selection, ISI Denpasar announced several things, including the number of participants passing the selection and the remaining quota having not yet been filled;

a suspension period of five working days after the announcement of the selection results; and procedures for the rebuttal of selection results.

2. Cara Pendaftaran

The passing of prospective new students of undergraduate/applied undergraduate program of ISI Denpasar through the independent channel is determined based on the ranking of the highest accumulated scores according to the capacity quota of the independent selection channel. Accumulated grades include the sum of the results of all assessment components consisting of:

1) Written test includes 30% cultural arts and Indonesian language knowledge; 2) Portfolio according to the chosen study program is 60%; and 3) The average grade for Senior High School/Vocational High School (SMA/SMK) or equivalent educations in semester I to semester V is 10%. The student registration process through independent channel has been provided by the Campus of ISI Denpasar via the website <https://natamahardika.isi-dps.ac.id/login>, prospective new students are given registration stages and procedures which can be downloaded from ISI Denpasar website, <https://isi-dps.ac.id/penbesaran-penerimaan-mahasiswa-baru-jalur-seleksi-mandiri-program-sarjana-dan-sarjana-terapan-institut-seni-indonesia-denpasar-tahun-akademik-2023-2024/> as shown in figure 3.4.1. Student admissions for undergraduate and applied undergraduate programs are carried out once a year.
